WHAG, in conjunction with the NBC affiliation, aired a number of PSA's "The More You Know" PSA's. The April total was 110, the May total was 95, and the June total was 96. The :10 and :30 themes of these PSA's deal with the environment, tolerance, mentoring, and violence prevention. The More You Know's website (www.nbc.com/tmyk) features scripts from the award-winning public service announcements, referral information for the organizations referenced in the PSA's, a general campaign overview, and educational materials produced in connection with NBC programming. The site also includes a list of the campaigns most recent accolades. During the quarter, there were 15 news stories appropriate for children that aired on either the 5PM or 6PM newscast. The content of these stories ranged from...At Greenbrier Elementary School in Hagerstown, students got together to form a school-wide fundraiser for the Washington County Humane Society...Senator Richard Alloway was in Chambersburg today visiting with a group of middle school students. It was all part of the school's annual ECO Day Field Trip...The sun is out and the heat is quite a scorcher outside! But that didn't stop families from attending "Arts in the Park" a performance by the Hagerstown Children's Theatre. Kids Cast - every Wednesday during our 5PM newscast weather segment, a third to fifth grade school student gives the weather forecast. Children draw a picture of "weather" and submit to our local Kids Cast sponsors. Each week, a picture is chosen, and the child who drew it sits in on our live news set and dekuvers tgekicak weather. The child arrives early and in addition to learning about the weather, they get to see how a live newscast works "behind the scenes:". During the month of April 61 30-second promos aired for the WHAG Student Athlete of the Month. During May 61 promos aired, and during the month of June 61 promos aired. The community nominates the students. Each month, a male and female athlete is chosen for their outstanding efforts in the classroom and on the field. A feature story is done on each winner and it airs within the local news. Congratulations promos air during the following month. On May 28 Dan Peck, Meteorologist went to Potomac Intermediate School in Martinsburg, WV to speak to approximately 200 students grades 3-5. He talked about the weather and what you have to do to become a meteorologist. On May 30, Amy Hudak, Reporter, went to Winchester Avenue Elementary School to meet with 120 students in grades k-3. She talked about being a reporter for WHAG. On May 31, Shayna Halper, Reporter went to West Frederick Middle School, Frederick, MD for Career Day. She met with approximate 60 8th grade students. She talked about what a reporter does. Hugh Breslin, VP and General Manager is on the Advisory Board of the Mason Dixon Council of the Boy Scouts.

Sean drives a double-decker bus into various communities to meet children who have written to him with a problem that they would like to solve using an art and/or food experience. Sean is accompanied by Noodle, a puppet character and Doodle, a digital character that lives inside a tablet computer, and Doggity, a faithful beagle. Doggity has a mini-show of his own through an animated alter-ego that appears during diversionary segments set in a restaurant kitchen. The show demonstrates how recycled materials can become art and how food, art, and problem solving can be combined to create a fun experience in everyday life. Every episode can be replicated at home with ease by parents and children playing together.
