Since February 18, 2009, the station has broadcast in digital format only, on the stations permanently-assigned digital channel 5. Due to breaking news the morning of Saturday, August 11 2012, SWAP.TV was preempted and TEEN KIDS NEWS was joined-in-progress. Both episodes were made good on Sunday, August 19 2012 at 2pm and 2:30pm respectively, and the makegood airings were promoted during childrens programming on Saturday, August 18. The station aired more than 450 minutes of Public Service Announcements during the 3rd quarter of 2012, designed for the education and benefit of children. As well, the station aired PSAs and promotions for local organizations and events benefiting children, such as Big Brothers Big Sisters, the Club for Boys, Girls Inc, 4-H, and Childrens Miracle Network.
