A complete listing of the PSAs which aired on 12.1 and 12.2 during this quarter can be found in our public file. The station sponsored several programs which engaged children and one such program is the Golden Apple Program. WDEF News Anchor Joe Legge through on air announcements, solicited students with the permission of their parents to nominate a teacher who has had a positive impact on their life. A teacher was then chosen by a panel of judges based on the students comments and then highlighted along with the nominating student on Tuesdays Newscast at 6. Another initiative sponsored by the station was a news segment called What's Right with Our Schools. WDEF News Anchor John Mercer featured a segment each Monday during the 6pm newscast highlighting educators, students, individuals or community groups which worked with the students and schools in an extraordinary manner and who went above and beyond the norm in helping to educate children through life lessons. An example of this was students from Washington Alternative Learning Center which planted their own outdoor garden. The students then made the garden available to the Washington Hills Community. The goal was to teach students how to grow vegetables and roses and to help feed and beautify the school and community. WDEF sponsored a Weather in the Classroom initiative. Station meteorologists visited 10 schools and over 798 students in fourth quarter educating students about weather patterns and on being prepared for dangerous weather situations. Presentations to children in the classroom were made at several area schools including West View Elementary, Big Ridge Elementary, Brown Academy, East Lake and Black Fox Elementary among others. WDEF Chief Meteorologist, Patrick Core has a program called Kidcasters where parents can go to our website and tell why their child would like to be a kidcaster. After a child is selected, they, along with their parents, are invited to the station to sit behind the scenes and observe a live news broadcast. Afterwards, the student gets to tape a weather report. They introduce themselves and tell what school they attend and then talk about the next days weather and rate it from an A to a F based on what kind of day they think it will be. They then get to shout out to family members or school mates. The segment is then played on our 11PM news that night and again the next morning on our morning news. Each child received a personalized Kidcaster Certificate and a DVD of their kidcaster weather report. This quarter we had children from the following schools. Ooltewah Middle School, Wallace A Smith Elementary, Lookout Valley Elementary, Ooltewah Elementary, Benton Elementary, Westside Elementary, Gilbert Elementary, and Hixson Elementary among other area schools. During the fourth quarter of 2014, WDEF also sponsored the following events which benefited children and families. Dalton Half Marathon-A fund raiser with proceeds going to City of Refuge in Dalton and Family Promise of Whitfield County. Both organization helps families who have fallen on hard times to recover and get back on their feet. The Shrine Circus with proceeds going to support the Shrine Hospital For Children which is dedicated to providing pediatric medical care regardless of ability to pay. Stars Golf Tournament which benefited the STARS-Students Taking A Right Stand Program and is designated a safe schools program in the Hamilton County Schools.
