The 10/3 episode of Xploration Animal Science had been rescheduled same day to air at 2p, due to sports. Because baseball ran very long that date, the program actually aired at 2:21-2:51p. Unanticipated network sports events caused extra pre- emptions of the 9-10a E/I schedule. Regular E/I schedules have been further adjusted starting 1st qtr 2016, with the hope of minimizing such possibilities.
