In each episode, Chica develops or encounters a problem that she cannot immediately resolve. Usually her issues involve impulse through an adventurea fantasy transformation to animationwhere Bunji and Stitches come alive and join Chica and Kelly for the problem solving process. The core educational content is primarily socio-emotional development as Chica learns how to express herself properly, think before she acts, and interact with other effectively. She often learns that it takes hard work and practice to become proficient at different skills.
