The network was put on notice and it remedied the issue, and KLTV has implemented additional procedures to monitor the presence of the E/I graphic. Station may rebroadcast some or all of the affected programming in the fourth quarter. KLTV performed the following non-broadcast efforts to benefit children during third quarter 2016: KLTV Chief Meteorologist Mark Scirto visited the Lindale Library and gave a weather presentation to 200 students on July 27.
