As a result, the station has been silent since early September and has been operating under an STA to remain silent since October 3, 2017. WOST has been off of the air for the entire quarter and no programming has aired during this time. This includes childrens programming. As of July 5, 2018, the Commission granted the WOST Modification of a DTV Station Construction Permit Application so that WOST can return to the air on a new channel. Once WOST is back on the air, it will resume its childrens programming.
