Each of these programs were identified by the Network as an "E/I" program to suppliers of program guides, and each was also introduced by an announcement stating that the following program is an "E/I" program. However, due to graphics error, the "E/I" logo failed to appear as a superimposition over each of the programs for the full duration of all program segments. THIS Network has corrected the error and the same programs were rebroadcasts in their respective second home, at the following dates and times listed below. These broadcasts were publicized by announcements on THIS Network, and the "E/I" logo was superimposed over each of the seven programs for the entire program duration in these rebroadcasts.
