The problem may be managing a bully, improving their grades, learning how to be altruistic, or protecting their enviornment from natural and man-made disasters. In most cases, they rely on Dr. Shell, the most venerated intellectual and elder in Shell Land who teaches them and gives them opportunities to harness their potential and solve the problem. Each episode provides a direct social-emotional lesson and many episodes provide information content relating to the sea life habitat of Shell Land and environmental conservation.
