On March 1, 2013, WMEI-TV entered into a program agreement with TEVE Romance LLC, which provides a series of programs that covers community issues as well as children's programming. However, as noted in a pending request for an STA, WOST-TV went off the air on February 25, 2013, and remains off the air. Accordingly, WOST was off the air from March 1, 2013 to March 31, 2013, and did not broadcast any children's television programming in this period. Nevertheless, from January 1, 2013 to February 24, 2013 the station had an average number of hours of Core programming per week of 4.0 hours.
