In the imaginary setting of L Town, characters' eating and fitness habits are linked to problem solving in their world. The lead chara Stephanie, a young girl who guides the audience through the story as she and her friends ("human" puppets) and her Uncle (Mayor Milford Meanswell) navigate life within Lazy Town. Robbie Rotten, the underground spy and influencer who personifies the ethos of Lazy Town, is determined to ruin the hea and fitness practices of Stephanie and her friends. When the kids have difficulty with Robbie Rotten, Sportacus (a gymnast/athlete prepared to answer any call for help) comes to the rescue from his home zeppelin-like aircraft that hovers over earth. The underlying themes of Lazy Town stress the importance eating "sports candy" (aka fruits and vegetables), always obtaining sufficient sleep, and going outside engage in a wide range of physical activities that include playing games, competing athletically, and ev building forts and play structures.
