Licensee's responses to this form therefore only apply to the station's digital program streams. After review of internal station records and documentation provided to us by program suppliers, the licensee hereby certifies as follows: (i) the only programs specifically designed for children ages twelve and under that the station broadcast this quarter are disclosed in this report and (ii) the licensee fully complied with FCC commercial limits, as specified at 47 C.F.R. section 73.670, with respect fo these programs. NOTE ABOUT THIS REVISED REPORT: At the request of Video Division staff, this Q1 2014 KAZA-TV Form 398 is being refiled to reflect revised responses to Questions 8(a) and 8(b) and Question 10. In Question 8(a), the total hours per week of programming aired on multicast streams was originally reported as 206.77 hours, reflecting the fact that KAZA-TV ceased operating channel 54.3 in mid-January, as reflected in the scheduling information for each program. Similarly, in Question 8(b), the total hours per week of Core programming on multicast streams was reported as 3.92 hours, reflecting the partial-quarter of operation on Channel 54.3. For the sake of clarity and ease of review, the responses have been revised to 336 total hours of programming and 6 hours of Core programming, reflecting the fact that both multicast streams aired the required 3 hours per week of Core programming for as long as each channel was operating. In Question 10, Program #9, the Total Times Aired at Regularly Scheduled Time was 3, rather than the previously-reported 6 times. This has been corrected. As further instructed by staff, a copy of the KAZA-TV Form 398 as originally filed is attached to this resubmission at Question 7(c), as proof of timely filing.
