- The permittee has specified the use of an ERI/Jampro rototiller (EPA Type 3), 4 section antenna to demonstrate compliance with the FCC radiofrequency electromagnetic field exposure guidelines. If any other type or size of antenna is to be used with the facilities authorized herein, THE AUTOMATIC PROGRAM TEST PROVISIONS OF 47 C.F.R. SECTION 73.1620 WILL NOT APPLY. In this case, a FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROGRAM TEST AUTHORITY must be filed with the FCC Form 302-FM, application for license, BEFORE program tests will be authorized. This request must include a revised RF field showing to demonstrate continued compliance with the FCC guidelines.

Special operating conditions or restrictions:

The University of Southern California was granted a waiver of 47 C.F.R. § 73.1125 to allow the operation of this station as a "satellite" of co-owned noncommercial educational FM Station KUSC(FM), Los Angeles, California (Facility ID No. 69318). See Letter to Lawrence Bernstein, Esq., reference 1800B3-ALM (Chief, Audio Services Division, Mass Media Bureau, August 13, 1997). Grant of this waiver is continued. The University of Southern California must abide by each representation proffered in the waiver request.
