- (1) The transfer of control of Access.1 Texas License Company, LLC shall take place subsequent to and/or simultaneously with the complete consummation of the assignment of license for the radio station specified in the application for consent to assignment of license for Station KCUL-FM, Marshall, Texas from Access.1 Texas License Company, LLC to Cosecha Communications LLC, as Trustee, (File Number BALH-20130301AAX).
- (2) License renewal applications are currently pending for the following stations:
- KKUS(FM), Tyler, Texas, Facility ID No. 68651
- KCUL(AM), Marshall, Texas, Facility ID No. 18262 KYKX(FM), Longview, Texas, Facility ID No. 54844 KFRO(AM), Longview, Texas Facility ID No. 70455

- KOOI(FM), Jacksonville, Texas, Facility ID No. 70740
- KOYE(FM), Frankston, Texas, Facility ID No. 70387

There are no basic qualifications issues outstanding with respect to the transferor and transferee that cannot be resolved in the context of the transfer proceeding, and (2) the transferee explicitly has agreed to succeed to the transferors' position with respect to any future renewal proceeding, consistent with the procedures set forth in Shareholders of CBS Corporation, Memorandum Opinion and Order on Reconsideration, 16 FCC Rcd 16072, 16072-73 (2001).

Under authority of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, the consent of the Federal Communications Commission is hereby granted to the transaction indicated above.

The Commission's consent to the above is based on the representations made by the applicants that the statements contained in, or made in connection with, the application are true and that the undertakings of the parties upon which this transaction is authorized will be carried out in good faith.

The actual consummation of voluntary transactions shall be completed within 90 days from the date hereof, and notice in letter form thereof shall promptly be furnished to the Commission by the seller or buyer showing the date the acts necessary to effect the transaction were completed. Upon furnishing the Commission with such written notice, this transaction will be considered completed for all purposes related to the above described station(s).
