Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, subsequent acts and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions set forth in this permit, the permittee is hereby authorized to construct the radio transmitting apparatus herein described. Installation and adjustment of equipment not specifically set forth herein shall be in accordance with representations contained in the permittee's application for construction permit except for such modifications as are presently permitted, without application, by the Commission's Rules.

- 3 Permittee has specified use of an eight bay, EPA type 3, circularly polarized, nondirectional FM transmitting antenna with 1.0-wavelength bay spacing, to demonstrate compliance with the FCC radiofrequency electromagnetic field exposure guidelines. If any other type or size of antenna is used with the facilities authorized herein, THE AUTOMATIC PROGRAM TEST PROVISIONS OF 47 CFR SECTION 73.1620 WILL NOT APPLY. In this case, a FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROGRAM TEST AUTHORITY must be filed in conjunction with FCC 302-FM, Application For FM Broadcast Station License, BEFORE program tests will be authorized. The request must include a revised RF field showing to demonstrate continued compliance with the FCC guidelines.

Special operating conditions or restrictions:

- 4 The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
