Dear Licensee:

This refers to the above mentioned application dated March 12, 2018, requesting special temporary authority to operate at reduced effective radiated power (ERP). You indicate that KURL is currently unable to operate at full power because one section of KURL's antenna overheated and caused damage to the antenna panel and the connecting feed line. KURL is currently operating at approximately 50% of licensed power. You mentioned that this power level allows KURL to continue to reach over 90% of its viewership.

In light of the above, special temporary authority is granted pursuant to sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's rules. This authorization expires on September 15, 2018.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
