Dear Licensee:

This refers to the above mentioned application dated March 13, 2018, requesting special temporary authority to operate at reduced effective radiated power (ERP). You indicate that On March 3, 2018, a liquid coolant line inside the transmitter cabinet burst flooding the cabinet interior with coolant resulting in a total loss of the transmitter. You mentioned that WVEBA immediately installed a spare lower powered transmitter such that WNPB can be back-on-the air until a new transmitter is purchased and installed.

In light of the above, special temporary authority is granted pursuant to sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's rules. This authorization expires on September 15, 2018.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
