Gentlemen:

This refers to the above application dated November 16, 2015 requesting special temporary authority to remain silent. You indicate that, in recent months, Prime Time Christian Broadcasting, Inc. (PTCB) has witnessed a sharp drop in underwriting revenue, due in large part to the effects of depressed oil prices in western Texas. As a result, PTCB has fallen behind in uplink and downlink program distribution payments to SES SA., a global satellite owner and operator. SES notified PTCB on November 5, 2015 that it was suspending transmission of network feed to the five stations including KMLM-DT, effective immediately. This move forced all five PTCB stations to go dark on November 5.

In light of the above, special temporary authority IS GRANTED pursuant to Sections 73.1740 of the Commission's Rules. This authorization expires on May 16, 2016.

During this period of discontinued operation, you are directed to pay strict attention to Section 73.1740 (a) (4). That is, you must continue to adhere to the requirements in your station license pertaining to the lighting of antenna structures.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
