This is in reference to the above-captioned displacement application and your request for Special Temporary Authority.

In light of the facts set forth therein, your request for Special Temporary Authority IS HEREBY GRANTED to operate in accordance with the specifications in your pending application. This authority is conditioned upon the avoidance of interference to any existing facilities. This authority expires July 23, 2018.

Pursuant to the Commission's rules for displaced Low Power Television and Television Translator stations, the displacement application will be treated as filed during the next displacement window<sup>1</sup> and, if grantable, will be placed on a proposed grant list and subject to the filing of petitions to deny. Barring disqualifying issues, final authorization for the facilities will be awarded at that time.
