Gentlemen:

This refers to your attorney's letter dated July 20, 2018, requesting special temporary authority to operate station KSWT at reduced power. You indicate that On July 12, 2018, several of the transmitter's RF amplifier pallets failed. As a result of these failures, the transmitter is only able to operate at 77 percent of its authorized power. You mentioned that because the transmitter manufacturer no longer has a presence in the United States and does not support the transmitter repair, Blackhawk has ordered a replacement transmitter.

In light of the above, special temporary authority is GRANTED pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules. This authorization expires on January 26, 2019.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
