Dear Licensee:

This refers to the above-mentioned application dated September 12, 2018, requesting special temporary authority to operate at reduced effective radiated power (ERP). You indicate the Station's Axcera transmitter for channel 16 has been malfunctioning, causing the Station to operate at 60% of authorized power, or an ERP of 45 kW. You mentioned that Lilly Broadcasting has been unable to obtain replacement parts for repair of the transmitter, because the transmitter manufacturer is no longer in business.

In light of the above, special temporary authority is GRANTED pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules. This authorization expires on March 19, 2019.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
