This refers to the above-mentioned application dated September 18, 2018 for further extension of your authority to remain silent. You indicate the Station's Pre-Incentive Auction facilities were destroyed by Hurricane Maria in September 2017. The Station has yet to resume operation with reduced facilities, and it is unlikely to do so prior to December 1, 2018. You mentioned that Telecinco is working diligently to construct an interim tower to permit the resumption of operations while it completes construction of the Station's post-Incentive Auction facilities. Telecinco's efforts have been delayed due to the lack of available tower construction crews and manufacturer delays in delivering the Station's post-Incentive Auction equipment. As a result, the construction of the Station's reduced facilities has not progressed as quickly as expected, and the Station will be silent beyond September 20, 2018.

Upon review of your extension request, it is evident your efforts are directed toward enhancing the operating efficiency of WRFB-TV. Accordingly, special temporary authority to remain dark pursuant to Sections 73.1740 of the Commission's Rules is EXTENDED until **December 1**, **2018**.

During this period of discontinued operation, you are directed to pay strict attention to Section 73.1740 (a) (4). That is, you must continue to adhere to the requirements in your station license pertaining to the lighting of antenna structures.
