Dear Licensee:

This refers to the above-mentioned application filed on March 20, 2019, requesting special temporary authority to operate at reduced effective radiated power (ERP). You indicate that since the existing KRTN-TV transmitter reached the end of its useful life, and its manufacturer is no longer in business, Ramar Communications, Inc. (Ramar), has needed to employ a temporary transmitter at reduced power. You mentioned that Ramar is pursuing plans to replace the permanent transmitter within approximately the next six months. Meanwhile, the station seeks to operate with a temporary transmitter at reduced power of 13 kW.

In light of the above, special temporary authority is **GRANTED** pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules. This authorization expires on **October 2, 2019**.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
