## Dear Licensee:

This is in reference to your August 13, 2019 request seeking special temporary authority (STA) to remain silent. You state that station KRMZ rebroadcasts the signal of KRMA, Denver, Colorado, as delivered by satellite and that the satellite service vendor, Comcast, has changed satellites requiring station KRMZ to obtain a new satellite receiver. As a result, station KRMZ has discounted operations as of July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

In light of the above, special temporary authority IS GRANTED pursuant to Sections 73.1740 of the Commission's Rules. This authorization expires on **January 15, 2020.** 

During this period of discontinued operation, you are directed to pay strict attention to Section 73.1740 (a) (4). That is, you must continue to adhere to the requirements in your station license pertaining to the lighting of antenna structures.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
