Dear Licensee:

This is in reference to your August 28, 2019 request seeking special temporary authority (STA) to operate TV station WCNC-TV, Charlotte, NC, on its post-transition channel using an interim antenna with alternate parameters while the station's main antenna is installed, and its post-auction main facility is completed.

After a thorough review of your technical specifications, we are persuaded that no interference is likely to occur from the proposed operation. We therefore conclude that the public interest would be served by the grant of this request. If problems do arise, we expect them to be solved expeditiously and the Bureau reserves the right to require the termination of the operation.

With respect to radio frequency radiation (RFR), we expect compliance with Section 1.1307(b) of the Commission's Rules to be achieved.

In light of the above, special temporary authority IS GRANTED pursuant to Section 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules. This authorization expires on **March 3, 2020**.
