## Dear Licensee:

This is in reference to your February 11, 2022 request seeking special temporary authority (STA) to continue operating TV station KVEO-TV, Brownsville, TX from the station's licensed site<sup>1</sup> with reduced power (500 kW), while repairs are completed.

After a thorough review of your technical specifications, we are persuaded that no interference is likely to occur from the proposed operation. We therefore conclude that the public interest would be served by the grant of this request. If problems do arise, we expect them to be solved expeditiously and the Bureau reserves the right to require the termination of the operation.

With respect to radio frequency radiation (RFR), we expect compliance with Section 1.1307(b) of the Commission's Rules to be achieved.

In light of the above, special temporary authority IS GRANTED pursuant to Section 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules. This authorization expires on **September 6, 2022.**
