

## **Special Operating Conditions or Restrictions**

The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

- This license is effective pursuant to 47 U.S.C. Section 307(c)(3).
- The licensee has demonstrated compliance with the FCC radiofrequency electromagnetic field exposure
  guidelines based on the use of the antenna specified herein. If the licensee makes any changes in the
  facilities via a modification of license application in accordance with 47 C.F.R. § 73.1690(c), the subsequent
  FCC application for license, must include a revised RF field showing to demonstrate continued compliance
  with the FCC guidelines.
- The relative field strength of neither the measured horizontally nor vertically polarized radiation component shall exceed at any azimuth the value indicated on the composite radiation pattern authorized by Construction Permit File No. 0000137898. A relative field strength of 1.0 on the composite radiation pattern authorized by Construction Permit File No. 0000137898 corresponds to the following effective radiated power: 100 kilowatts. Principal minima and their associated field strength limits: 220 to 320 degrees True (clockwise): 4.0 kilowatts.
- The authority granted herein is subject to the condition that the field strength produced by the permittee's /licensee's facility shall not exceed 27 mV/m as measured at the Federal Communications Commission's Waipahu, Hawaii monitoring station. In the event that this limitation is exceeded or if interference is caused to monitoring, direction finding, or related operations at the Federal Communications Commission's Waipahu, Hawaii monitoring station, including that caused by either harmonic or spurious radiation, the permittee /licensee shall take such immediate corrective action as is necessary to eliminate the interference. This shall include responsibility for furnishing, installing and adjusting transmitter filter circuits, shielding, or other corrective devices. If these measures fail to eliminate the interference to FCC operations caused by the presence of the permittee's/licensee's signal, or if the field intensity exceeds 27 mV/m, the permittee/licensee shall immediately reduce power to the extent necessary to eliminate the interference and/or comply with the field strength limit. After determining this lower power level, the permittee/licensee shall immediately apply for a Special Temporary Authority (STA) and shall file an application with the Commission for the altered parameters. Documentation demonstrating compliance with this special operating condition, including the results of the field strength measurements, must be submitted with the FCC application for license.
- Grant of this license application is conditioned upon the continuous operation of the licensed facility for the twelve-month period following grant, including specifically: (a) operation of the station in accordance with the station's FCC authorization with (i) an antenna mounted on a pole, tower, or other structure that is attached to a durable, non-movable structure, (ii) the antenna connected to a permanent power source, and (iii) if located on public property, advance approval by a written governmental authorization; and (b) operation of the station each day in accordance with the FCC's rules for minimum operating schedule (47 C.F.R. § 73.1740(a) for FM stations, 47 C.F.R. § 73.561(a) for NCE-FM stations and 47 C.F.R. § 73.850(b) for LPFM stations) without recourse to the procedures set out in 47 C.F.R. §§ 73.1740(a)(4), 73.561(d), and 73.850(d). The failure of the station to operate in compliance with any of the foregoing requirements will result in the rescission of this grant, dismissal of the license application and the forfeiture of the associated construction permit pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3598(e) unless the licensee rebuts the resulting presumption that the authorized facilities were temporarily constructed. Evidence of non-temporary construction could include, but is not limited to, station logs, utility bills, lease documents, photographs of the installed antenna/transmitter/studio equipment, and other relevant documentation.

Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent acts and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions set forth in this license, the licensee is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting apparatus herein described.

This license is issued on the licensee's representation that the statements contained in licensee's application are true and that the undertakings therein contained so far as they are consistent herewith, will be carried out in good faith. The licensee shall, during the term of this license, render such broadcasting service as will serve the public interest, convenience, or necessity to the full extent of the privileges herein conferred.

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequency designated in the license beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934.
