Dear Mr. Kinney:

This is in reference to the request filed on August 22, 2023. HMG requests a further extension of the STA granted on June 7, 2016, to continue operating with DA parameters at variance to allow time to file the required minor change application in LMS to permanently change from a DA to ND facility.¹ In support of the request, HMG stated that it has retained an engineer to assist in preparing and filing the application in the upcoming months.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:


- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is GRANTED, and HMG may continue to operate with DA parameters at variance and reduced power while maintaining all monitor points within licensed limits. HMG must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See 47 CFR §1.1310.*

¹ KKLS(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 920 kHz with 5 kW day and 0.111 kW night, using different patterns.

This authority expires on **February 28, 2024.** ²

²Periods of operation pursuant to this STA shall be recorded in the station's records (see 47 CFR § 73.1820). The records shall include start/stop dates and times of such operation. These log entries must be maintained for a minimum of two years as specified in 47 CFR § 73.1840(a), unless a longer retention period is requested by the staff. Periods of operation may be subject to independent verification that they in fact occurred.
