Special Operating Conditions or Restrictions

The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

- Prior to commencing program test operations, FM Translator or FM Booster permittee must have on file an Application for an FM Translator or FM Booster Station License, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 74.14.
- Pursuant to the waiver of 47 CFR Section 74.1233(a)(1) granted herein the permittee/licensee shall be subject to a holding period. The permittee/licensee may NOT change the AM primary station listed on this authorization. Once a license application is filed to cover this construction permit, this facility is required to rebroadcast this AM primary station for four years. Periods of station silence shall not count toward the fulfillment of this four-year requirement. During this same four year period the permittee/licensee may not assign or transfer the construction permit/license to another party, unless it is to the licensee of the AM station being rebroadcast the AM station for this authorization are permitted, provided the translator will continue to rebroadcast the AM station for which the waiver was granted.

Equipment and program tests shall be conducted only pursuant to Sections 73.1610 and 73.1620 of the Commission's Rules.
