## Dear Mr. Henderson:

This is in reference to the request filed on October 3, 2023. SCHC requests a further extension of the STA granted on October 3, 2022, to continue operating ND with reduced power to allow time to file the required direct measurement of power application (302-AM) in LMS after installing two new replacement towers to replace those destroyed by Hurricane Ian in 2022.¹ In support of the request, SCHC stated that a tower crew is being scheduled to move forward with the project to restore licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and SCHC may continue to operate ND using either tower #2 or #4 with a maximum of 1.25 kW daytime and 0.75 kW nighttime. SCHC must reduce day or night power further or cease operations if

complaints of interference are received, and must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on April 11, 2024. <sup>2</sup>

Periods of operation may be subject to independent verification that they in fact occurred.
