- The permittee has specified the use of an EPA Type 2 (Opposed V Dipole), 8 section antenna to demonstrate compliance with the FCC radiofrequency electromagnetic field exposure guidelines. If any other type or size of antenna is to be used with the facilities authorized herein, THE AUTOMATIC PROGRAM TEST PROVISIONS OF 47 C.F.R. SECTION 73.1620 WILL NOT APPLY. In this case, a FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROGRAM TEST AUTHORITY must be filed with the FCC Schedule 302-FM, Application for License, BEFORE program tests will be authorized. This request must include a revised RF field showing to demonstrate continued compliance with the FCC guidelines.
- BEFORE PROGRAM TESTS COMMENCE, sufficient measurements must be made to establish that the
 operation authorized in this construction permit is in compliance with the spurious emissions requirements of
 47 C.F.R. Sections 73.317(b) through 73.317(d). All measurements must be made with all stations
 simultaneously utilizing the shared antenna. These measurements must be submitted to the Commission with
 the FCC application for license.
- FAA INTERFERENCE CONDITION: Upon receipt of notification from the Commission that harmful
 interference is being caused by the operation of the permittee's/licensee's transmitter, the permittee/licensee
 must either immediately reduce the power to the point of no interference, cease operation, or take such
 immediate corrective action as is necessary to eliminate the harmful interference. This condition expires after
 one year of interference-free operation.

Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, subsequent acts and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions set forth in this permit, the permittee is hereby authorized to construct the radio transmitting apparatus herein described. Installation and adjustment of equipment not specifically set forth herein shall be in accordance with representations contained in the permittee's application for construction permit except for such modifications as are presently permitted, without application, by the Commission's Rules(See Section 83.875).

Pursuant to Section 73.3598, this Construction Permit will be subject to automatic forfeiture unless construction is complete and application for license is filed prior to expiration.

Equipment and program tests shall be conducted only pursuant to Sections 73.1610 and 73.1620 of the Commission's Rules.



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
