Dear Mr. Maxwell:

This is in reference to the request filed on December 12, 2023. DMBL requests a further extension of the STA granted on May 31, 2019, to continue operating from an alternate site to allow time to file the required 302-AM license to cover applications in LMS for this station and KBOZ(AM).<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, DMBL stated that additional time will be needed to file the applications after all required changes to the existing KBOZ antenna system have been completed.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and DMBL may continue to operate with the following facilities:

<sup>1</sup> KOB(AM) is licensed for ND operation on 1230 kHz with 1 kW (day and night), and BP-20220422AAH authorizes relocation to the existing KBOZ southeast tower using 1 kW (day and night).

These log entries must be maintained for a minimum of two years as specified in 47 CFR § 73.1840(a), unless a longer retention period is requested by the staff. Periods of operation may be subject to independent verification that they in fact occurred.
