



## Special Temporary Authority For a Radio Broadcast Station

In keeping with Footnote 76 of the March 11, 2024 staff letter to Davis Broadcasting of Atlanta, L.L.C. (the licensee of FM translator W266BW), Davis requests a reduced effective radiated power (ERP) STA at 0.006 kW (six watts) using the facilities authorized in license 0000186272. The current STA request includes a showing contending that this reduced power operation will not cause interference at the listening locations referenced in the March 11 letter.

Therefore, Special Temporary Authority (STA) IS GRANTED for operation of the station above with the parameters specified in the STA request only and the effective radiated power (ERP) limited to **0.006** kW (six watts). The licensee is responsible for addressing any complaints of interference that may arise.

**This STA authority expires September 10, 2024.** The grant of this STA does not imply any decision on the matters raised in conjunction with W266BW's license 0000186272.

Please file any future STA extension request on or shortly before the date that the current STA expires. Late filings will require a new FM Engineering STA request and resubmission of all engineering data for the temporary operation.

Considerations:

Licensee must take all steps to ensure that workers and the public are not exposed to radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure limit.

This Special Temporary Authority does not supersede any non-FCC-regulated requirements applicable to the STA-authorized facility. The licensee remains solely and wholly responsible for maintaining compliance with such requirements.

Requests for extension of STA may be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Periods of operation pursuant to this STA shall be recorded in the station's records (see 47 CFR §§ 73.1820 (AM/FM/TV), 73.877 (LPFM) and/or 74.1281 (FM translator)). The records shall include start/stop dates and times of such operation. These log entries must be maintained for a minimum of two years as specified in 47 CFR § 73.1840(a), unless a longer retention period is requested by the staff. Periods of operation may be subject to independent verification that they in fact occurred.
