## Dear Mr. Hearne:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 19, 2024. GCB requests a further extension of the STA granted on June 5, 2019, to continue operating ND with reduced power due to the pending 301-AM minor change application (0000241470) file to permanently change to ND operation. In support of the request, we noted that additional time will be required for our staff to review and take further action on the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and GCB may continue to operate ND with 1 kW day and night, using one of the licensed site towers. GCB must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.
