Dear Mr. Do:

This is in reference to the request filed on April 3, 2024. Intelli requests a further extension of the STA granted on April 20, 2021, to continue operating from an alternate site to allow time to file the required 301-AM minor change application in LMS to propose a new permanent facitly (due to loss of the licensed site four years ago). In support of the request, Intelli stated that it is in the process of selling the station to a new licensee that will have to file the required application to move forward towards resumption of licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is hereby GRANTED, and Intelli may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Hours of operation Daytime and Nighttime

Operating power 0.010 kW
