Dear Licensee:

This is in reference to your December 05, 2019 request seeking special temporary authority (STA) to continue operating TV station WAPA-TV, San Juan, Puerto Rico, from the station's interim transmitter site with reduced facilities while the station's main facility is modified and made operational after damage caused by Hurricane Maria.

After a thorough review of your technical specifications, we are persuaded that no interference is likely to occur from the proposed operation. We therefore conclude that the public interest would be served by the grant of this request. If problems do arise, we expect them to be solved expeditiously and the Bureau reserves the right to require the termination of the operation.

With respect to radio frequency radiation (RFR), we expect compliance with Section 1.1307(b) of the Commission's Rules to be achieved.

In light of the above, special temporary authority IS GRANTED pursuant to Section 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules. This authorization expires on **June 10, 2020.**
