Special Operating Conditions or Restrictions

The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

- Board of Trustees, University of Florida requests waiver of 47 C.F.R. § 73.509 to allow Station WUFT-FM, as authorized herein, to receive contour overlap from the 100 dBu contour of third adjacent channel Station WWLC(FM), Cross City, FL (Facility ID No. 121772) on Channel 203C3. We have afforded this request the "hard look" called for under *WAIT Radio v. FCC*, 418 F.2d 1153 (D.C. Cir. 1969), and find that the facts and circumstances presented in the applicant's justification are sufficient to establish that grant of the requested waiver is in the public interest. Accordingly, waiver of 47 C.F.R. § 73.509 IS HEREBY GRANTED. Furthermore, further modifications of Station WWLC(FM) will not be construed as a "per se" modification of WUFT-FM's facility. (See Educational Information Corporation, 6 FCC Rcd 2207 (1991)).

Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, subsequent acts and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions set forth in this permit, the permittee is hereby authorized to construct the radio transmitting apparatus herein described. Installation and adjustment of equipment not specifically set forth herein shall be in accordance with representations contained in the permittee's application for construction permit except for such modifications as are presently permitted, without application, by the Commission's Rules (See Section 83.875).

Pursuant to Section 73.3598, this Construction Permit will be subject to automatic forfeiture unless construction is complete and application for license is filed prior to expiration.

Equipment and program tests shall be conducted only pursuant to Sections 73.1610 and 73.1620 of the Commission's Rules.
