> Re: Request for Invoice Deadline Extension for W25FC-D, Jasper, Alabama Facility ID No. 166986 LMS File No. 0000198602

Dear Licensee,

On August 29, 2022, Combs Broadcasting, Inc. (Combs or Licensee), licensee of W25FC-D, Jasper, AL (Station or W25FC), filed the above-captioned application requesting extension of W25FC's invoice filing deadline¹ for the TV Broadcaster Relocation Fund (the Reimbursement Fund or Fund) from the third and final invoice filing assignment deadline of September 6, 2022, to a new invoice filing deadline of March 6, 2023.² For the reasons discussed below, we grant, in part, the Request and extend the date of the Station's invoice filing deadline to December 6, 2022.

Background. Pursuant to the Commission's direction, the Incentive Auction Task Force and Media Bureau set deadlines for final invoice submission to the Reimbursement Fund using a phased assignment approach.³ All repacked low-power television and translator stations were directed to submit remaining invoices and supporting documentation using the Reimbursement Form, and initiate interim close-out procedures, no later than September 6, 2022.⁴ We stated that we did not anticipate a need to grant extensions because the deadline was more than a year after the July 13, 2020, statutory end of the transition period and more than a year after the announcement of the invoice filing assignment deadline. We noted, however, that if an entity faced circumstances beyond its control, we could consider a limited extension.⁵ An entity requesting such an extension was required to provide evidence that circumstances requiring the extension were outside of its control, such as local zoning or a force majeure event occurring

proximate to the final submission deadline.⁶ We further stated that we would not grant extensions that do not provide the staff with sufficient processing time to complete close-out procedures for all stations.⁷ On August 4, 2022, we issued a final reminder to Fund entities that outstanding invoices must be filed by the September 6 deadline and that we did not anticipate further extensions of the invoice filing deadline, barring limited extensions requested by entities that are able to provide evidence that circumstances outside of their control, such as local zoning or a force majeure event occurring proximate to the final submission, would necessitate a limited deadline extension.⁸

Licensee contends that circumstances beyond its control warrant a six-month extension of the September deadline. Specifically, Licensee states that, although it constructed the Station's facilities "approximately one year ago," the tower crew "discovered rust and other structural issues with the station tower that required attention to support the new station antenna per industry standards."⁹ Further, Combs states it has worked with outside general contractor Branch Communications to "facilitate a modified tower design" and as recently as two months ago was confident that the tower work would be completed and invoices generated in time to meet the September 6, 2022 deadline. Licensee states, however, that due to "a lack of available tower crews and other personnel, as well as other supply chain issues, the modified tower design was delayed in recent weeks and completion of the work to modify the tower will now not be possible until later this year."¹⁰ Licensee submits that extension of the invoice submission deadline — from September 6, 2022 to March 6, 2023 — is warranted.

Discussion. Upon review of the facts and circumstances presented, we find that sufficient circumstances exist to grant a limited extension of the Station's invoice filing deadline from September 6, 2022 to December 6, 2022. The Station has provided information supporting a three-month extension. We also find that grant of the Request is not likely to negatively impact the staff's ability to process the Station's invoices or complete close-out procedures for all stations. We therefore conclude that the public interest will be served by grant of the extension. We strongly encourage the Station to diligently pursue submission of all remaining invoices and initiate close-out procedures as early as possible without waiting for the December 6, 2022 deadline. We remind the Station that, pursuant to the Spectrum Act, stations are eligible for reimbursement for costs "reasonably incurred . . . in order for the licensee to relocate its television service from one channel to the other."¹¹ Additional expenses incurred, such as expenses resulting from changes in a station's transition plan that are not related to the post-incentive auction channel change, may not be reimbursable from the Fund.

We caution the Station that we do not anticipate allowing further extensions of the final December 6, 2022 invoice filing deadline. A station's failure to complete any remaining construction in a timely manner and to make final submissions by the revised invoice filing deadline could preclude that station from receiving full reimbursement. Unobligated amounts in the Fund must be rescinded to Treasury and the Commission staff (with the support of the Fund Administrator)

must have sufficient time to fully process all reimbursement requests and complete close-out procedures prior to July 3, 2023.¹² The Fund Administrator will initiate close out procedures if the Station fails to initiate interim close-out procedures by the December 6, 2022 invoice filing deadline, and any unused allocations made to the Station's account will be returned to the Fund.

In consideration of the above facts, the request for extension of the invoice filing assignment deadline for Station W25FC-D **IS GRANTED**. The invoice filing assignment deadline for the Station **IS MODIFIED TO December 6, 2022**.
