> RE: WAMT(AM), Pine Castle Sky Lake, FL Facility ID No. 15877 Silent since September 29, 2022 Request for Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. McCormick:

This letter concerns the request you filed on October 3, 2022, on behalf of Family Stations, Inc. (FSI), for Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit AM Radio Station WAMT to remain silent.

FSI's request states that Station WAMT(AM) went silent on September 29, 2022, for technical reasons.

FSI's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WAMT(AM) to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WAMT(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., September 30, 2023.¹

FSI is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If FSI does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
