Facility ID No. 49573 Silent since April 19, 2022 Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Ms. Crump:

This letter concerns the request you filed on December 13, 2022, on behalf of William C. Gleich (Gleich), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit FM Radio Station WFDX to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that Gleich stated that Station WFDX(FM) went silent on April 19, 2022, for financial reasons. The previous STA was granted on July 8, 2022, and will expire on January 4, 2023. Gleich requests extension of its STA for continuing financial reasons.

Gleich's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WFDX(FM) to remain silent until April 19, 2023. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WFDX(FM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., April 20, 2023.

Gleich is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If Gleich does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
