**Special Operating Conditions or Restrictions**

- Pursuant to 47 CFR Sections 73.7002(c) and 73.7005(b) the permittee/licensee is required to construct and operate for a period of four years of on-air operations technical facilities substantially as proposed and shall not downgrade service to the area on which the preference was based.
- Pursuant to 47 CFR Sections 73.7005(a) and 73.7005(c), the permittee/licensee must maintain its comparative qualifications and comply with the restrictions on assignments/transfers. From the grant of the construction permit until the station has achieved at least four years of on-air operations, the permittee /licensee must maintain the comparative characteristics for which it received points and comply with the restrictions on station modifications and acquisitions. If the permittee/licensee proposes to assign/transfer the construction permit/license to another party during the period from grant of the construction period until the station has achieved at least four years of on-air operations, it must demonstrate the following two factors: (1) that the proposed buyer would qualify for the same number of or greater points as the assignor or transferor originally received, and (2) that consideration received and/or promised does not exceed the assignor's or transferor's legitimate and prudent expenses.
- This construction permit expires 36 months after November 16, 2022, the grant date of the construction permit (0000166682). Commission rules which became effective on February 16, 1999, have a bearing on this construction permit. See Streamlining of Mass Media Applications, Report and Order, MM Docket No. 98-43, 13 FCC Rcd 23056 (1999). Pursuant to these rules, consummation of the assignment consented to herein will not extend the expiration date of the permit. The construction permit will be subject to automatic forfeiture unless construction is complete and an application for license to cover is filed prior to expiration.

Under authority of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, the consent of the Federal Communications Commission is hereby granted to the transaction indicated above.

The Commission's consent to the above is based on the representations made by the applicants that the statements contained in, or made in connection with, the application are true and that the undertakings of the parties upon which this transaction is authorized will be carried out in good faith.

The actual consummation of all transactions shall be completed within 90 days from the date hereof, and notification thereof shall promptly be furnished to the Commission by the seller or buyer showing the date the acts necessary to effect the transaction were completed. Upon furnishing the Commission with such notification, this transaction will be considered completed for all purposes related to the above described station(s).

FCC Form 323 or 323-E, Ownership Report, must be filed within 30 days after consummation, by the licensee /permittee or assignee.

**ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ASSIGNMENTS ONLY**

Upon consummation the assignor must deliver the permit/license, including any modifications thereof to the assignee.

The assignee is not authorized to construct nor operate said station(s) unless and until the Commission has been notified of consummation.
