Dear Mr. Dennning:

This is in reference to the request filed on September 25, 2023. CLL requests a final extension of the STA granted on November 3, 2022, as last modified on March 29, 2023, to continue operating with a reduced daytime power level to allow time to install the new 5 kW daytime transmitter.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, CLL stated that the transmitter has been delivered, and the installation will be completed as soon as possible.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and CLL may continue to operate with a reduced nominal daytime power of 1 kW with no change to the licensed nighttime DA operation. CLL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See 47* CFR §1.1310. After CLL has installed the new transmitter, a Restoration of Licensed Operation notice must be filed in LMS to certify the date the station was able to resume licensed operations per BMML-20150821ACA with negligible changes to all engineering parameters.

This authority expires on April 5, 2024.<sup>2</sup>

The records shall include start/stop dates and times of such operation. These log entries must be maintained for a minimum of two years as specified in 47 CFR § 73.1840(a), unless a longer retention period is requested by the staff. Periods of operation may be subject to independent verification that they in fact occurred.
