Dear Mr. Neely:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 9, 2024. RFPJY has requested one final extension of the STA originally granted on April 20, 2018, to continue operating from an alternate site to allow time to file the required license application to cover BP-20190906AAU before the permit expires on April 1, 2024.¹ In support of the request, RFPJY stated that it is waiting on the power company to install an electric meter at the new site in order to file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and RFPJY may continue to operate with the following facilities:

¹ WGIV(AM) is licensed for ND operation on 1370 kHz with 16 kW day and 0.045 kW night, and BP-20190906AAU authorizes a new ND site facility with different power levels.

RFPJY must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on April 1, 2024.²

²Periods of operation pursuant to this STA shall be recorded in the station's records (see 47 CFR § 73.1820). The records shall include start/stop dates and times of such operation. These log entries must be maintained for a minimum of two years as specified in 47 CFR § 73.1840(a), unless a longer retention period is requested by the staff. Periods of operation may be subject to independent verification that they in fact occurred.
