The permittee/licensee must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines. Special operating conditions or restrictions:

The licensee has demonstrated compliance with the FCC radiofrequency electromagnetic field exposure guidelines based upon the usage of the antenna specified herein. If the licensee makes any changes in facilities via modification of license application in accordance with 47 CFR section 73.1690(c), the subsequent Form 302-FM, application for license, must include a revised RF field showing to demonstrate continued compliance with the FCC quidelines.

The specified antenna exceeds the FCC's radiofrequency electromagnetic field strength guidelines at the base of the tower (roof of the mechanical penthouse) and on the roof of the main building. The permittee/licensee is required to ensure that locked doors will restrict access to the roof and to the penthouse. RF hazard warning signs will be affixed to all access doors.
