- The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
- BEFORE PROGRAM TESTS COMMENCE, sufficient measurements shall be made to establish that the operation authorized in this construction permit is in compliance with the spurious emissions requirements of 47 C.F.R. Sections 73.317(b) through 73.317(d). All measurements must be made with all stations simultaneously utilizing the shared antenna. These measurements shall be submitted to the Commission along with the FCC Form 302-FM application for license.

Special operating conditions or restrictions:

- Warning signs, which describe the radiofrequency radiation hazard, must be posted at appropriate intervals. Access to the site must be restricted to prevent the exposure of humans to radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC Guidelines in OET Bulletin No. 65, Edition 97-01, August 1997. Please note, persons allowed access to the site, who are not employees of a radio station, must be protected to the public (uncontrolled) RF radiation limit of 0.2 mW/cm2 (200 uW/cm2). The permittee must submit documentation of compliance with this special operating condition with the FCC Form 302-FM, application for license.
- Permittee has specified use of the antenna listed below to demonstrate compliance with the FCC radiofrequency electromagnetic field exposure guidelines. If any other type or size of antenna is to be used with the facilities authorized herein, THE AUTOMATIC PROGRAM TEST PROVISIONS OF 47 C.F.R. SECTION 73.1620 WILL NOT APPLY. In this case, a FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROGRAM TEST AUTHORITY must be filed in conjunction with FCC Form 302-FM, application for license, BEFORE program tests will be authorized. The request must include a revised RF field showing to demonstrate continued compliance with the FCC quidelines.
