Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, subsequent acts and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions set forth in this permit, the permittee is hereby authorized to construct the radio transmitting apparatus herein described. Installation and adjustment of equipment not specifically set forth herein shall be in accordance with representations contained in the permittee's application for construction permit except for such modifications as are presently permitted, without application, by the Commission's Rules.

Commission rules which became effective on February 16, 1999, have a bearing on this construction permit. See Report & Order, Streamlining of Mass Media Applications, MM Docket No. 98-43, 13 FCC RCD 23056, Para. 77-90 (November 25, 1998); 63 Fed. Reg. 70039 (December 18, 1998). Pursuant to these rules, this construction permit will be subject to automatic forfeiture unless construction is complete and an application for license to cover is filed prior to expiration. See Section 73.3598.

Equipment and program tests shall be conducted only pursuant to Sections 73.1610 and 73.1620 of the Commission's Rules.

It is to be expressly understood that the issuance of these specifications is in no way to be considered as precluding additional or modified marking or lighting as may hereafter be required under the provisions of Section 303(q) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

Special operating conditions or restrictions:

- 1 The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
- 2 Permittee has specified use of an ERI Model BEMP-3E, 3 bay antenna to demonstrate compliance with the ANSI radiofrequency radiation limit. If any other type or size of antenna is to be used with the facilities authorized herein, THE AUTOMATIC PROGRAM TEST PROVISIONS OF 47 C.F.R. SECTION 73.1620 WILL NOT APPLY. In this case, a FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROGRAM TEST AUTHORITY must be filed in conjunction with FCC Form 302-FM, application for license, BEFORE program tests will be authorized. This request should be made at least 10 days prior to the date on which program tests are desired to commence. The request must include a revised radiofrequency radiation showing to demonstrate continued compliance with the ANSI limit.
Documentation demonstrating compliance with the ANSI radiofrequency radiation limit may be submitted in advance of the filing of FCC Form 302-FM. The Commission's staff will review it for compliance and respond by letter stating whether automatic PTA has been reinstated.

Special operating conditions or restrictions:

- 3 Warning signs which describe the radiofrequency radiation hazard must be posted at appropriate intervals. Access must be restricted to prevent the exposure of humans to radiation in excess of the American National Standards Institute guidelines (OST Bulletin No. 65, October 1985). Permittee shall submit documentation of compliance with this special operating condition when filing FCC Form 302, application for license.
- 4 When filing FCC Form 302, application for license, permittee must submit a statement from the manufacturer of the directional antenna used by co-located FM translator Station K208BP, Wenatchee, WA certifying that implementation of the facilities authorized herein would not adversely affect the operation of Station K208BP.
