## Special operating conditions or restrictions:

- 1 The relative field strength of neither the measured horizontally nor vertically polarized radiation component shall exceed at any azimuth the value indicated on the composite radiation pattern authorized by this construction permit BPED-20180510AAC.

A relative field strength of 1.0 on the composite radiation pattern herein authorized corresponds to the following effective radiated power:

12.0 kilowatts(H) & 11.5 kilowatts(V) .

Principal minima and their associated field strength limits:

220 - 240 degrees True: 0.38 kilowatt  
280 degrees True: 0.38 kilowatt.

- 2 Grant of this license application is conditioned on the continuous operation of the licensed facility for the twelve-month period following grant. The failure of the facility to so operate will result in the rescission of this grant, dismissal of the license application and the forfeiture of the associated construction permit pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3598(e) unless the licensee rebuts the presumption that the authorized facilities were temporarily constructed.
- 3 The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
- 4 The licensee has demonstrated compliance with the FCC radiofrequency electromagnetic field exposure guidelines based upon the usage of the antenna specified herein. If the licensee makes any changes in facilities via modification of license application in accordance with 47 CFR section 73.1690(c), the subsequent Form 302-FM, application for license, must include a revised RF field showing to demonstrate continued compliance with the FCC guidelines.
