Special operating conditions or restrictions:

Program tests for WRCC-FM will not commence on Channel 269A until program tests for WKTM commence on Channel 291A and a license will not be granted for WRCC-FM on Channel 269A until a license is granted for WKTM on Channel 291A.

Before program test is authorized by the Commission a fence must be erected at a distance of at least 5 meters from the base of the tower and in such a manner as to prevent the exposure of humans to radiofrequency radiation in excess of The American National Standards Institute Guidelines (OST Bulletin No. 65, October 1985). The fence must be of a type which will preclude casual or inadvertent access, and must include warning signs at appropriate intervals which describe the nature of the hazard. Permittee shall submit documentation of compliance with this special operating condition along with the Form 302-FM, application for license.

The permittee/licensee must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency radiation in excess of FCC quidelines.
