Permittee has specified use of an EPA Type 3 rototiller, two section antenna to demonstrate compliance with the ANSI radiofrequency radiation limit. If any other type or size of antenna is to be used with the facilities authorized herein, THE AUTOMATIC PROGRAM TEST PROVISIONS OF 47 C.F.R. SECTION 73.1620 WILL NOT APPLY. In this case, a FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROGRAM TEST AUTHORITY must be filed in conjunction with FCC Form 302-FM, application for license, BEFORE program tests will be authorized. This request should be made at least 10 days prior to the date on which program tests are desired to commence. The request must include a revised radiofrequency radiation showing to demonstrate continued compliance with the ANSI limit.

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Documentation demonstrating compliance with the ANSI radiofrequency radiation limit may be submitted in advance of the filing of FCC Form 302-FM. The Commission's staff will review it for compliance and respond by letter stating whether automatic PTA has been reinstated.
