- 3 The relative field strength of neither the measured horizontally nor vertically polarized radiation component shall exceed at any azimuth the value indicated on the composite radiation pattern authorized by Construction Permit BPH-19990812IA.

A relative field strength of 1.0 on the composite radiation pattern authorized by Construction Permit BPH-19990812IA corresponds to the following effective radiated power:

50 kilowatts

260 through 300 degrees True: 39.694 kilowatts
